Minutes

The City Council of the City of Laurinburg held a special meeting August 28, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. in the council room of the Municipal Building with the Honorable Matthew Block, Mayor, presiding. The following Councilmembers were present: Rembert DeBerry, Amanda B. Faulk, and Curtis B. Leak. Councilmembers Thomas W. Parker, III and Herbert M. Rainer, Jr. were absent.

Also present were Craig F. Honeycutt, City Manager, and Dolores A. Hammond, City Clerk.

Mayor Block called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Councilmember DeBerry gave the invocation.

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Block explained that this public hearing is for citizen input to discuss the City's intent to apply for a Community Development Block Grant for Infrastructure. The proposed project is for sewer line replacement on Creedle & Morris Streets.

Mr. Bill Riemer, Director of Administration and Development, explained that there are inflow and infiltration problems in this area. He stated that all work will be in the streets and not in the citizens' yards.

He then declared the public hearing open.

There was no one present to discuss the project.

Mayor Block then closed the public hearing.

Following discussion, motion was made by Councilmember DeBerry, seconded by Councilmember Faulk, and unanimously carried to send a letter of interest to the North Carolina Department of Commerce for the 2008 Community Development Block Grant for sewer line replacement.

Motion was made by Councilmember DeBerry, seconded by Councilmember Faulk, and unanimously carried to adjourn the meeting.
