

**CITY OF LAURINBURG  
RECONVENED AND JOINT MEETING  
MARCH 7, 2013  
LOBBY OF LAURINBURG-MAXTON AIRPORT COMMISSION

5:30 p.m.**

The City Council of the City of Laurinburg reconvened its March 6, 2013 meeting on March 7, 2013 at 5:30 p.m. in the lobby of the Laurinburg-Maxton Airport Commission, located at 16701 Airport Road. This was a joint meeting with the Laurinburg-Maxton Airport Commission and the Town of Maxton Commissioners with the honorable Thomas W. Parker III, Mayor, presiding. The following Councilmembers were present: Mary Jo Adams, Kenton T. Spencer, Curtis B. Leak, Mary Jo Adams, Andrew G. Williamson, Jr. and J.D. Willis.

Ms. Angie Mettlen of WK Dickson, Mr. Joe McGougan of Marziano & McGougan, and Ms. Jan Maynor Executive Director of the Lumber River Council of Governments and Mr. Jim Perry, former Executive Director of the Lumber River Council of Governments were also present.

Mayor Parker reconvened the March 6, 2013 meeting at 5:32 p.m.

Ms. Mettlen and Mr. McGougan discussed the need for preserving the water and discharge permits from the WestPoint Stevens Water and Wastewater Plant and the need to preserve these infrastructures for future growth in the County.

A lengthy discussion ensued concerning the water and discharge permits and potential funding sources.

Motion was made by Councilmember Spencer, seconded by Councilmember Williamson, and unanimously carried to support the Laurinburg-Maxton Airport Commission in its efforts to investigate purchasing the WestPoint Stevens Water and Wastewater Plant.
