## Leaf Season is Here

With the fall comes the increased volume of leaves that will be collected by the City of Laurinburg Sanitation Dept. As a reminder, leaves are collected loose at the curb by City vacuum trucks. Therefore, it is very important to keep leaves separated from all other types of debris year round. Please do not rake your leaves into the street, do not put leaves in any type of container (must be loose), and always place leaves in an easily

accessible area away from vehicles or other obstructions.

The timeliness of collection will depend on the volume of leaves set out for collection. During peak times, collection intervals could be as high as three (3) weeks. Thank you for your cooperation and patience.

**Aluminum Cans; Steel Cans; All plastics with #1 - #7 on bottom (does NOT include Styrofoam); Magazines; Mixed office and computer paper; Corrugated Cardboard; Clear, Brown, and Green glass bottles; Used Oil (secured in a plastic bottle with a tight cap)**

**Please place ONLY these items in the blue cart. All other household items should be placed in the green garbage cart.**

## HOLIDAY SANITATION SCHEDULE

*The City of Laurinburg will be closed on Thursday, Nov. 22nd and Friday, Nov. 23rd for the Thanksgiving Holiday. Also the county landfill will be closed on Wednesday November 21st due to a furlough day. Therefore, the solid waste routes for Monday and Tuesday of that week will be picked up on Monday. Solid waste routes for Wednesday and Thursday of that week will be picked up on Tuesday. Commercial garbage dumpsters will be picked up on Monday and Tuesday. Commercial cardboard dumpsters will be picked up on Wednesday as scheduled.*



*The City of Laurinburg will be closed on Monday, December 24th, Tuesday, December 25th, and Wednesday, December 26th for the Christmas Holidays. All solid waste routes for Monday and Tuesday, will be picked up on Thursday, December 27th and all solid waste routes for Wednesday and Thursday will be picked up on Friday, December 28th.*

*The City of Laurinburg will be closed on Tuesday, January 1st 2012 for the New Year's Day Holiday. All solid waste routes scheduled for Tuesday will be picked up on Wednesday of that week.*
